During this powerful presentation, Dr. Fowlin transforms himself into eight student characters of different backgrounds facing a variety of issues both in and out of the classroom, including racial identity, gender equity, violence prevention, suicide, homophobia , and the emotional pain often suffered by special-needs children. Dr. Fowlin challenges his audiences to face the impact of ignorance and fear and to become more empathetic towards others. His highly original presentations— seen by over a million people— bring a heightened awareness to students and adults alike. Dr. Fowlin suggests real-world SOLUTIONS. This "dance with diversity" in which Dr Fowlin assumes, in turn, many roles,

is based on his own experiences and combines both his training in Psychology, as well as well-honed professional acting talents. as well-honed professional acting talents.

Through this unique role-playing program Dr. Fowlin hopes that all audience members will leave with a sense of the awakening of beauty— the beauty both of individuals, and of the beauty inherent within the community of mankind. 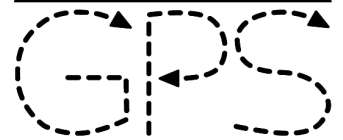
